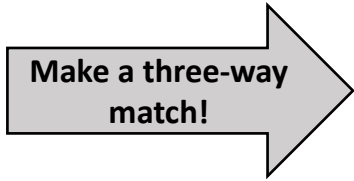

What do you think "INTERMODAL" means?

Bonus Answer: Intermodal transport means putting stuff in a big metal box - also called a "container" - and then using multiple modes of transportation (e.g., rail, ship, and truck) to get that container to its final destination. So when you see a truck on the highway with a container attached, it might have been on a ship or a train (or both) before hitting the road...or it might be on its way to a railroad or port!
