I really enjoy the variety of the work and that no two days are ever the same. I'm always learning new things through my interactions with other people, and I love getting to know the children and the families who visit all the time.

## What do you find most challenging about your job?

Working with the public can sometimes be challenging, but it is also very rewarding.
